Vendors agree to stay until 4 PM for both days. Security will be provided when the show is closed.

DIRECTIONS: Williams Grove is located west of Harrisburg and south of the Pennsylvania Turnpike along US Route 15.

FROM THE NORTH: Take US Route 15 south 2.5 miles from the Turnpike to the Lisburn Rd. exit ramp. At the bottom of the ramp turn right and drive 1.7 miles to the second traffic light at Williams Grove Road. Turn left and drive 1.2 miles to the show grounds entrance on the right.

FROM THE SOUTH: Take US Route 15 north and turn left onto PA Route 74 at Dillsburg. Drive 1.2 miles to the Exxon Station and turn right onto Williams Grove Road. It is 0.8 miles to the show grounds entrance on the left.

FROM THE EAST OR WEST: Use any route that will take you to US Route 15 and then follow the directions for approaching from the north or south as described above.

Be sure to look for the white railroad cross bucks marked “Williams Grove Train Show” ... they will point the way to the Williams Grove Historical Steam Engine Association’s Show grounds, along Williams Grove Road.
